Students must accumulate a total of **72 modular credits** from a combination of <u>major core</u> and <u>major option</u> modules, except for students pursuing a double major programme.

BREADTH REQUIREMENT

Students must accumulate a minimum of **68 modular credits** from a combination of compulsory breadth, outside faculty breadth, remaining breadth modules and including modules taken in the Discovery Year.

Outside faculty breadth and remaining breadth modules

At least 20 modular credits (outside faculty breadth and remaining breadth modules) will have to be taken from outside the faculty, of which at least 4 Modular Credits must be taken from the Faculty of Science (FOS), Institute of Health Science (IHS) or Faculty of Integrated Technologies (FIT).

LEVEL REQUIREMENT

- 1. Students must read and pass <u>a maximum of 40 modular</u> <u>credits of Level 1000 modules</u>.
- 2. Students must have complete <u>a minimum of 24 modular</u> credits of Level 4000 modules in their major subject.
- 3. The rest of the level requirement can be read at either Level 2000 or Level 3000 modules.

MAJOR MINOR REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Students may take a major-minor route if they wish to gain an additional specialisation. Major-minor route are <u>not compulsory</u>.
- 2. Students wishing to take the major-minor route may do so by completing a minimum of **72 modular credits** in their declared single **major** discipline, and a minimum of **24 modular credits** as specified by the programme where they wish to take the **Minor** (from another <u>faculty</u>).
- 3. Students must complete their study within a maximum of six years.
- 4. Students outside ABS may choose to study a minimum of 24 modular credits of ABS modules as minor.

DOUBLE MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

To qualify, applicants will need to meet the following requirements:

- 1. Satisfy the Bachelor of Arts Major in Brunei Studies admission requirements.
- 2. Maintain a <u>cGPA of 3.0</u> in the first two semesters in their first year of study.
- 3. Apply to pursue a double major at the end of the second semester of candidature.
- 4. Obtain the Director's recommendation to pursue a double major.
- 5. Students need to declare their double major at the beginning of the third semester of candidature.

DOUBLE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

To qualify, applicants will need to meet the following requirements:

- 1. Satisfy the Bachelor of Arts Major in Brunei Studies admission requirements.
- 2. Maintain a <u>cGPA of 3.5</u> in the first two semesters in their first year of study.
- 3. Apply to pursue a double degree at the end of the second semester of candidature.
- 4. Obtain the permission from Director/ Dean of both faculties.

DISCOVERY YEAR PROGRAMME

Students are required to undertake two semesters of Discovery Year Programme.

It is comprised of any one (1) or a combination of:

- 1. Study Abroad Programme (1-2 semesters),
- 2. Internship (1-2 semesters),
- 3. Community Outreach Programme (1-2 semesters)
- 4. and/or Innovation or Incubation projects (1-2 semesters)

All students must attain 32 modular credits during the Discovery Year.

The grades gained for Discovery Year Programme are not counted towards GPA and cGPA calculations.

ACADEMIC ADVISORS

All academic staff will act as academic advisors, where his/her roles and responsibilities include:

- 1. Acting as a mentor to the assigned group of students;
- 2. To counsel and discuss with students on any issues related to academic progress, whenever required;
- 3. Keeping track of students' progress throughout the whole duration of degree; and
- 4. Liaising with Dean of Students where and when necessary.
